


Immortal In Death (1996)


youth and fame. One that led from the runway to the dark underworld of New York City where drugs could fulfill any desire -- for a price...

They died with smiles on their faces. Three apparent suicides: a brilliant engineer, an infamous lawyer, and a controversial politician. Three strangers with nothing in



Ceremony In Death (1997)


Conducting a top secret investigation into the death of a fellow police officer has Lieutenant Eve Dallas treading on dangerous ground. She must put

Vengeance In Death (1997)







She'd lost her badge and had nearly lost her way too recently for the sting to have faded. Now that she had both back, she wasn't ready to set duty aside. An






Seduction In Death (2001)




Reunion In Death (2002)



Louie Cogburn had spent three days holed up in his apartment, staring at his computer screen. His pounding headache was unbearable - like spikes drilling into his






Imitation In Death (2003)


Divided In Death (2004)




Survivor In Death (2005)






Memory In Death (2006)

Born In Death (2006)


Eve Dallas has a grisly double homicide to solve when two young lovers-both employees of the same prestigious accounting firm-are brutally killed on the

A recent emigrant from London, Tandy has few friends in New York, and no family-and she was really looking forward to the party. Innocent In Death (2007)




couldn't capture. When the body of a young brunette is



others - especially those in which the victim is a prominent businessman, found in his Park Avenue apartment, tied to the bed - and strangled - with cords of black velvet.




Salvation In Death (2008)

Promises In Death (2009)


Amaryllis Coltraine may have recently transferred to the New York City police force from Atlanta, but she's been a cop long enough to know how to defend herself against an assailant. When she's

Dallas's friend Chief Medical Examiner Morris had started a serious relationship with Coltraine, and from all accounts the two were headed for a happy future together. But someone has put an end to all that. After breaking the news to Morris, Eve starts questioning everyone, including Coltraine's squad, informants, and neighbors, while Eve's husband, Roarke, digs into computer data on the dead woman's life back in Atlanta. To their shock, they discover a connection between this case and their own painful, shadowy pasts.

The truth will need to be uncovered one layer at a time, starting with the box that arrives at Cop Central addressed to Eve, containing Coltraine's guns, badge, and a note from her killer: 'You can have them back. Maybe someday soon, I'll be sending yours to somebody else.'

But Eve Dallas doesn't take too kindly to personal threats, and she is going to break this case, whatever it takes. And that's a promise.




Kindred In Death (2009)

Bart Minnock, founder of the computergaming giant U-Play, enters his private playroom, and eagerly can't wait to lose himself in an imaginary world, to play the


role of a sword-wielding warrior king, in his company's latest top-secret project, Fantastical.


Eve and her team are about to enter the next level of police work, in a world where fantasy is the ultimate seduction-and the price of defeat is death...




Treachery In Death (2011)

take her all the way to the city that gave her her name - and plunge her into the nightmares of her childhood.






Delusion In Death (2012)
