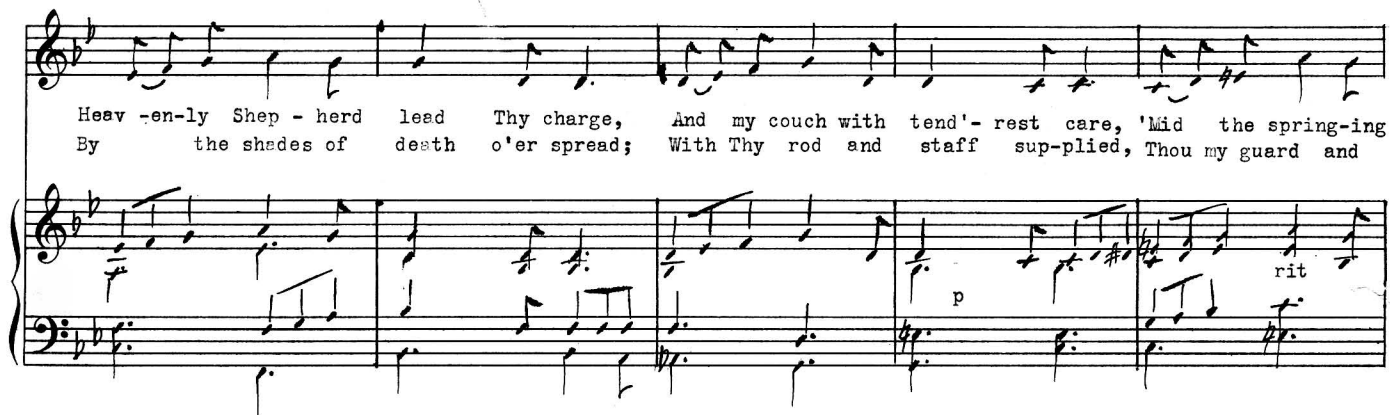

2. Safe the dreary vale I tread,

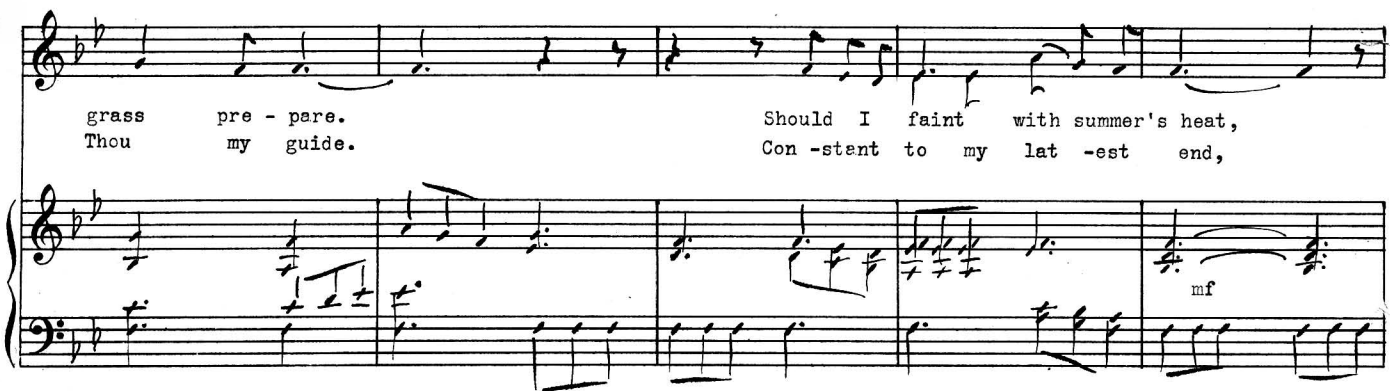


Heav-en-ly Shep-herd lead Thy charge, And my couch with tend'-rest care, 'Mid the spring-ing
